Thank you for signing up for Orchestra, it is going to be a great year! I'm excited to get to know you as we progress together toward musical excellence. Every student can improve their ability to lay if they are willing to work hard and keep trying. I want to help you improve technique, form and skill as strive to play your best. Together we will create beautiful music.

This is a performance based course where practice at home is key. You will be expected to perfect your parts at home and come to class daily to rehearse as an ensemble. At your advanced level, you can be counted on to know your parts and play your best to support the Orchestra. Also, be prepared for extra repetition as I feel this is the best way to learn and acheive greatness. We have some exciting pieces and I look forward to hearing you play with outstanding tone quality and precision.

Two Class Rules:

#1: Be Respectful#2: Be Responsible

My Job (Mrs. Vallejo):

- (Respectful): I will treat each student with respect and support them as they improve their reading and playing skills. I will give positive praise and enthusiastic encouragement. I will respectfully correct tone and rhythmic errors. Our class is a safe place to learn and put ourselves "out there" as musicians.
- (Responsible): My job is to come to class prepared to teach and manage our class. I will set daily goals within our pieces to perfect our sound. I will model solid String form, technique and tone production. I will guide students in note reading, rhythm, theory and history.

Your Job (Student):

- (Respectful): Come to class on time, be focused and ready to work. Be willing to shut off verbal communication while
 we rehearse. Negativity is not welcome. During rehearsal time, please listen quietly. Be willing to teach others what
 you know.
- (Responsible): Bring to class every day: your instrument, music and a pencil. Larger instruments may borrow school outfits here during class (bass and cello). *Practice daily,* attend all performances. Progress will happen if all students work at it every day. You are responsible to maintain your instruments (repairs, strings).

Parent Job:

• Provide an instrument for your student (rented, borrowed, purchased) and maintain it (broken strings, repairs, accessories). School instruments \$50 per trimester. [rental night at ACYI Aug 30th 6:30-8:30]

• Support your student by: 1) Encouraging daily practice (90 min weekly...15 min day...minimum), sign charts. 2) Come to our performances. You will be amazed at what young people can do. (Website has all dates)

Grading:

- 50% Participation and written work. (10 points daily total. Tardy = minus 5, excessive talking minus points)
- 25% Weekly Practice reports (Due Fridays, signed by parents). 90 minutes a week for full points.
- 25% Performance attendance (one each trimester, see schedule)
